Mark,

We brought in to Au-Ve-Co approx 410 ton of #57 limestone from Hilltop's Butler Quarry.

Ashcraft hauled in approx 50 loads of dirt from the corner of Martin Luther King and Reading Road in Ohio.

Ashcraft hauled in another 20 loads from Planet Fitness which is being built behind Walmart on 17.

We hauled in from St Timothy's church for one day with 5 trucks, so that was approx 25 loads.

We had a Friend of Billy's bring in approx 30 loads from a basement excavation job in Fort Thomas.

So all told we hauled in 125 loads of dirt. Approx 30 loads were delivered to us for no cost.

The haul out was less. We found a dump site close to the new Larosa's and we hauled 18 loads there. Another Friend of Billy's was building a house in Campbell County and we hauled approx 35 loads to him. Total loads hauled our approx 53.

We plan on exporting more loads as part of the second phase of work.
